SUBJECT: New Golf Rates

Summary:

This item is for the introduction and first reading of an ordinance amending the code of ordinances of the City of Fredericksburg, Article 24.100 changing the effective date of the ordinance and adding a new section, section (h) regarding fees for members of the area high school golf team during the regular school year.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed amended ordinance.

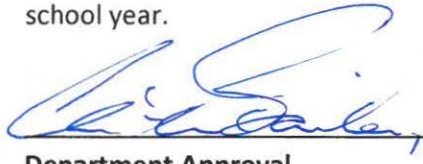
Background / Analysis:

At their regular meeting on September 19th, the City Council approved the partial amendment of this ordinance which expanded "residential rates" to Bandera, Blanco, Burnet, Gillespie, Llano, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble and Mason counties. The effective date of this ordinance was January 1, 2017. This proposed ordinance amendment changes the effective date from January 1, 2017 to November 1, 2016 and adds a

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE ARTICLE 24 RECREATIONAL FEES, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 24.100 GOLF FEES TO INCLUDE RESIDENTS OF THE SURROUNDING COUNTIES OF BANDERA, BLANCO, BURNET, LLANO, KENDALL, KERR, KIMBLE AND MASON COUNTIES IN THE LIST OF PERSONS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR RESIDENT GUEST RATES FOR GOLFING AT LADY BIRD JOHNSON MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE, DEFINING JUNIOR MEMBER RATES, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, REPEALING INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR PARTIAL INVALIDITY

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Fredericksburg has determined that in order to encourage use of its facilities, that the fees for the use of the City's Lady Bird Johnson Municipal Golf Course should be amended as the same are set forth below; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE BE AND IS HEREBY ENACTED AND THAT APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE **ARTICLE 24.000, RECREATIONAL FEES** OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG BE AMENDED, AND SPECIFICALLY THAT **ARTICLE 24.100 GOLF COURSE FEES** BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 24.000. RECREATIONAL FEES

Section 24.100. Fees for use of Lady Bird Johnson Municipal Golf Course

(a) GUEST RATES FOR RESIDENTS OF BANDERA, BLANCO, BURNET GILLESPIE, LLANO, KENDALL, KERR, KIMBLE AND MASON COUNTIES (rates remain as written)

(b) GUEST RATES FOR NON RESIDENTS OF BANDERA, BLANCO, BURNET GILLESPIE, LLANO, KENDALL, KERR, KIMBLE AND MASON COUNTIES (rates remain as written)

(e) JUNIOR RATE FOR RESIDENTS OF BANDERA, BLANCO, BURNET GILLESPIE, LLANO, KENDALL, KERR, KIMBLE AND MASON COUNTIES WHO ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER (rates remain as written)

(f) JUNIOR RATE FOR NON RESIDENTS OF BANDERA, BLANCO, BURNET GILLESPIE, LLANO, KENDALL, KERR, KIMBLE AND MASON COUNTIES WHO ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER (rates remain as written)

(g) JUNIOR MEMBER RATE FOR THOSE WHO ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER

Season Ticket rate: \$90.00 per year effective from April 1 to March 31 of each calendar year (remaining Green Fee and Cart rates remain as written)

(h) FOR MEMBERS OF THE AREA HIGH SCHOOL GOLF TEAM DURING THE REGULAR SCHOOL YEAR Golf team members from area high schools will be charged the Junior Members Season Ticket Rate per team member. This ticket rate will cover their green fees for the entire school year. The high schools to which this rate applies will be as determined by the Lady Bird Johnson Golf Course Director of Golf.

The rates set out above will be effective November 1st, 2016.

-----End of Code Text-----

Severability / Invalidity.

If any provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without defeating the purpose or objective of the provisions, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Repealer

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Penalties

Penalties provided for in the Code Ordinances of the city of Fredericksburg shall apply to violations hereof.
