Background / Analysis:

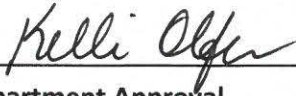

SUBJECT: 1st Amendment to Boot Ranch Reclaimed Water Service Agreement

Summary:

City Staff has met with Boot Ranch Staff to discuss an increase in the reclaimed water sales rate, as well as making a few revisions to the reclaimed water agreement made in March 2008.

Recommendation:

City Staff recommends approval of the First Amendment of the Boot Ranch Reclaimed Water Service Agreement.

Background / Analysis:

Boot Ranch and the City entered into a Reclaimed Water Service Agreement in March 2008. Currently, the City of Fredericksburg sells an annual average of 80 million gallons of reclaimed water to Boot Ranch at a rate of \$0.35 per thousand gallons.

Over the past couple of months, City Staff has met with Boot Ranch Staff to discuss increasing the reclaimed water rate and making revisions to the existing reclaimed water agreement. City Staff and

Boot Ranch are currently discussing the proposed amendments to the Reclaimed Water Service Agreement:

- Irrigation of the golf course and common areas depicted on the amended plan.
- Extension of the Reclaimed Water Service Agreement to November 2041 (25 years from proposed amendment).
- City to treated reclaimed water to the TCEQ Reclaimed Water Type I Regulation, in lieu of Type II which is currently stated in agreement.
- Increase the reclaimed water rate from \$0.35 per thousand gallons to \$0.66 thousand gallons. The City will evaluate the reclaimed water sales rate annually as part of the City budget.
- Capital expenses in excess of \$5,000 per incident shall be paid for by Boot Ranch with contractors, materials, engineering and the like with approval by the City prior to commencement of work.

FIRST AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT
RECLAIMED WATER SERVICE AGREEMENT
UTILITY CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT (this "Agreement"), made this _____ day of _____, 2016, by and between TX 77 BOOT RANCH CIRCLE LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("TX 77") and the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG (the "City"). (Boot Ranch to provide ownership documentation. Has there been a transfer of the golf course or other common area subject to this agreement?)

RECITALS:

A. Boot Ranch Real Estate, LLC ("Boot Ranch") and the City entered into that Reclaimed Water Service Agreement/Utility Construction Contract dated as of March 6, 2008 (the "Agreement"), with respect to the real property owned by Boot Ranch and more commonly known as the "Boot Ranch" in Fredericksburg, Texas (the "Property").

B. TX 77 foreclosed the Deed of Trust on April 6, 2010 on the property covered by the Agreement as is evidenced by Trustee's Deed recorded under Document Register No. 20101410 of the Official Public Records of Gillespie County, Texas, and is now the owner of the property subject to the said Reclaimed Water Agreement, and TX 77 by instrument dated _____ assumed the obligations under the Agreements and the City consented thereto.

C. TX77 and the City now desire to amend the Agreement and enter into this amendment to evidence the changes in the Agreement.

AGREEMENTS

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the extension of the term of the Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The recitals above are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. TX 77 does hereby warrant, certify and affirm to the City that it is the successor in interest to "Developer" in each of the above described Agreements, and is the owner of the Property subject to said Agreements, except the lots which have been sold to individual property owners, and that it is fully authorized to assume the rights and responsibilities of "Developer" in each of said Agreements, and
3. TX 77 does hereby ratify its assumption all of covenants, conditions, obligations, liabilities and responsibilities required to be performed by "Developer" with respect to the Agreement.
4. The specific provisions of the Agreement are hereby changed and are agreed to as follows:

A. Section I. F. Golf Course. The area to be irrigated shall include the Golf course and all of the common areas depicted on the amended plan attached hereto. **ADD EXHIBIT**

B. Section I. I. Reclaimed Water Wastewater produced at the City of Fredericksburg's wastewater treatment plant and processed to a minimum of Type I classification as denominated by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Reclaimed water is sometimes referred to as wastewater or effluent.

C. Section II. A.1 Reservation of Capacity/Usage. Developer shall have reserved for it the water capacity as agreed to under the provisions of this Contract for the Golf Course for a period of twenty five (25) years from the date of this amendment. The remainder of Section II. A.1 shall remain as written.

D. Section IV.

A. 1. Service Fees. The reclaimed water will be sold to Developer, its successors or assigns, based on a unit price per 1,000 gallons, delivered at the Point of Delivery, derived from the cost of delivery incurred by the City plus twenty-five percent (25%). The price of the wastewater effluent shall be set initially at sixty-six cents (\$0.66) per 1,000 gallons beginning_____, 2016, and then adjusted annually based on the previous calendar year's actual cost of delivery incurred by the City, plus twenty-five (25%) percent but shall not be less than \$0.66 per thousand. The cost of delivery shall include, but is not limited to, pumping power costs, the normal operation and maintenance costs required for pumping the wastewater effluent to the Point of Delivery, for maintenance/and or replacement of lines, repair and maintenance of equipment costing less than \$5,000.00 per incident, and future requirements, if any, of TCEQ or other regulatory agency with jurisdiction other than the City.

A. 2. Capital Expense. Any maintenance or replacement costing in excess of \$5,000.00 per incident shall be performed by TX 77 at its expense. All repair, maintenance, replacement, contractors, material, engineering and the like shall be approved by the City prior to commencement, and shall be to City standards.

5. The parties acknowledge that the Agreement and this amendment constitute the entire agreement with regard to the subject matter thereof, and that no default shall exist under either of the Agreements.
6. This Agreement may be executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but both of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.

SUBJECT: Agreement for Trolley Services

Summary:

Based upon the discussion at the last City Council meeting, the attached agreement for trolley services has been prepared for your consideration.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Council review and discuss the attached agreement for trolley services and make any changes you deem appropriate prior to approval.

Background / Analysis:

At the recent City Council Retreat, Becky Howard with Fredericksburg Tours LLC presented her plans to operate trolley services within the City. She and her husband have recently purchased several 28-seat trollies. They plan to provide trollies for special tours as well as a fixed route system between local hotels and the downtown area. She outlined her request for City support for the fixed route system.

At the last City Council meeting Mrs. Howard provided additional information in support of her request for several types of assistance from the City. This included \$7,092 a month in HOT funds for start-up funding for the fixed route system. The Council indicated that they were not in support for this funding

and suggested that Mrs. Howard might want to apply for HOT funds during the normal funding process which will be considered in January.

Mrs. Howard also requested funding for the placement of signs designating trolley stops and access to City fuel with these fuel costs reimbursable to the City. She also requested that they be allowed to store and stage the trollies at the Consolidated Warehouse. The Council indicated that you would be willing to consider these requests. The attached agreement includes provisions for the City providing this support.

AGREEMENT FOR PROVISION OF TROLLEY SERVICE

THE STATE OF TEXAS §
 § KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:
COUNTY OF GILLESPIE §

This Agreement made effective this the ____ day of November, 2016, by and between the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS, a municipal corporation of Gillespie County, Texas, sometimes hereinafter called CITY and FREDERICKSBURG TOURS, LLC, sometimes hereinafter called LLC , each acting herein by and through its duly authorized officers.

I.

The CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS, by authority of powers granted to it under state statutes enters into this contract with LLC for the provision of trolley services within the City limits of the City of Fredericksburg.

II.

For and in consideration of the LLC providing and conducting tours and providing a trolley service to encourage tourists and convention delegates to visit the City of Fredericksburg or its vicinity as hereinafter described, the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG and the LLC hereby agree as follows:

The terms of this agreement are:

1. The public Works Department of the City of Fredericksburg, in conjunction with the LLC, the City of Fredericksburg Police Department and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") will determine the location of up to 20 stopping and loading places within the City and designate the same as trolley stops.

2. The City will pay up to the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) to the Public Works Department for up to 20 trolley stop signs and for other expenses of designating the trolley stops at the locations described in 1. above. The Public

Works Department will design the signs which shall be generic as to trolley stop, subject to the rules of TxDOT. and may, at the discretion of the Public Works Department contain a schedule. The signs shall be installed on or before December 31, 2016.

3. The LLC will be entitled to park its trollies at the City's consolidated warehouse property at 233 Friendship Lane during operating hours for the purposes of checking and servicing them, changing drivers and the like, but not for overnight storage.

4. The LLC will be entitled to purchase gasoline from the City's Public Works Department at its cost for the trolly portion of its business, but not the tour portion of its business. The LLC will keep accurate records of usage and will account for the same on a monthly basis if the same vehicles are used for trolly and tour services. This is not necessary for vehicles dedicated to trolly service only. Payments shall be due and made upon invoice from the City. The City may deny the right to further purchases if any payment is not made within ten (10) days of the invoice date or require immediate payment for future purchases.

5. LLC will conduct trolly services on a regular schedule from ____ am to ____pm at least on Saturdays and Sundays, and at other times as it determines. Such service shall include stops at eight (8) hotels within the City limits at minimum and shall utilize the stops described in 1. above on the routes. The same are to be approved by the City in conjunction with the director of the Convention and Visitor's Bureau.

III.

It is expressly understood and agreed by and between the parties that the LLC is hired and engaged as an independent contractor and is not an officer, agent or employee of the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG.

IV.

The LLC will, on request of the governing body of the municipality or other of its agents, make the records available for inspection and review to the governing body and provide reports of ridership and any information it has regarding the number of out of town residents using the service to the City Manager of the City of Fredericksburg at least each three months beginning March 1, 2017.

The organization, by acceptance hereof, agrees to comply with the above requirements.

V.

This Agreement shall begin on the execution date hereof and shall continue in force until December 31, 2017. This Agreement may be terminated by the CITY upon thirty (30) days notice for noncompliance with the terms of the Agreement.

VI.

Any notice necessary or appropriate relative to this Agreement shall be effective when deposited in the United States mails, either certified or registered mail, postage prepaid and addressed to the City Manager of the City of Fredericksburg, City Hall, 126 West Main Street, Fredericksburg, Texas 78624 or to the LLC at _____, Fredericksburg, Texas 78624.

VII.

No part of this Agreement may be assigned or delegated without the prior written consent of the other party, and any attempted assignment of benefits or rights of delegation of duties or obligations shall be a breach of this Agreement.

VIII.

This Agreement shall be subject to the laws and statutes of the State of Texas.

IX.

INDEMNITY CLAUSE

The LLC agrees to and shall indemnify and hold harmless and defend the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, losses, causes of action and damages, suits, and liability of every kind including all expenses of litigation, court costs, and attorney fees, for injury to or death to any person, or for damage to any property, arising from or in connection with the operations of the LLC, its officers, agents and employees carried out in furtherance of this Agreement. It is the expressed intention of the parties hereto, both the LLC and the CITY, that the indemnity provided for in this paragraph is also indemnity by the LLC to indemnify and protect the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG from the consequences of the CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG'S own negligence, where the negligence is a concurring cause of the injury, death, or damage.

X.

It is expressly agreed that by executing this Agreement with the LLC, the CITY does not bind itself in the future as to any action of the City Council in connection with the allocations hereunder.

XI.

Each party warrants and represents that it has approved this Agreement by resolution duly adopted at a meeting of its governing body by a majority of those present and voting and that the chief executive officer of each party are duly authorized to enter into this Agreement on behalf of such party.

SUBJECT: Letter of Intent-Park Property

Summary:

The City is proposing to purchase park property and a Letter of Intent has been drafted for this purchase.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council discuss the terms of the Letter of Intent to purchase this property in executive session. Following executive session, and a discussion on the terms and conditions, if the terms and conditions of the Letter of Intent are agreeable to the Council, then it is recommended that this Letter of Intent be approved. It is also recommended that the City Manager be authorized to proceed with the execution of an earnest money contract according to the approved terms and conditions.

Background / Analysis:

Over the past year the City has been attempting to purchase sufficient property for additional baseball, softball and soccer fields. The staff has identified a possible tract and we have been negotiating this purchase with a realtor representing the owner. The City's purchase would be contingent upon passage of a bond issue for the purchase of the land and development of a sports complex. This bond proposal will be presented to City voters next May.

To date, I have not received the proposed changes to the Letter of Intent from the realtor. It is expected that his comments will be received the next several days and I will present this information to the City Council.

SUBJECT: Budget Amendments

Summary:

There are several budget amendments that need to be approved as a result of three capital projects that were not completed last year and due to Blanco National Bank's procedure for handling lease purchases this year.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the budget amendments described below and listed in the attachment be approved.

Background / Analysis:

Every year the City has budget amendments that require Council approval. This year we hope to minimize the number of amendments that are required for the Council to consider.

The first group of budget amendments that are requested involve capital projects that were not completed by 9/30/16 that we plan to complete this year. This includes the following:

1. Consolidated Warehouse Drainage Channel-General Fund-\$209,000
The original FY 2016 Budget for this project was \$292,800. Last year \$110,600 was spent on these improvements leaving a balance of \$182,200. However, we have several small change

orders pending on this project and we have agreed to spend about \$5,000 to plant some additional replacement trees on the Eckhart property. Therefore, we now anticipate that \$209,000 will need to be expended this year to complete this project.

2. Marktplatz Improvements-Tourism Fund-\$68,500

The approved FY 2016 Budget for this project was \$100,000. A total of about \$31,500 was spent last year on drainage and electrical improvements. We need to budget the remaining \$68,500 in order to complete these improvements in the coming year.

3. Administration Building at Water Reclamation Plant-Water Fund-\$115,000

The FY 2016 Budget for this building was \$450,000. In developing the FY 2017 Budget, we anticipated that \$225,000 would be expended last year and the remaining \$225,000 would be spent during the current year. However, we only expended \$110,000 last year. Therefore, we need to amend the current budget for the additional \$115,000 so that we can complete the purchase and installation of this building.

The second group of budget amendments involves the equipment items that we plan to lease purchase this year. In the past the financial institution handling the lease purchase of city equipment held the funds in an escrow account and disbursed payments to the vendor when the City received the equipment. However, Blanco National Bank issued the City a check for the lease purchase revenues and requested that the City disbursement of the funds. Therefore, the City needs to amend the budget for the revenues received from the lease purchase proceeds and for the equipment expenditures shown on the attached page.

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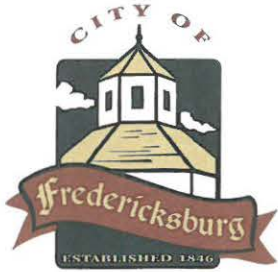

Hotel Occupancy Tax Applicants:

It's that time of year!!!

The City Council will hear 2017 Hotel/Motel Tax Funding Requests at their January 16, 2017 meeting. SUBJECT: Appointment of Sound Ordinance Advisory Committee

Summary:

The Council has previously recommended that a Sound Ordinance Advisory Committee of 7-9 members be appointed to review and make recommendations on possible revisions to the City's sound ordinance. In addition, it was agreed that membership on this Committee would be restricted to City residents and owners of businesses within the City Limits.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council review the attached applications and appoint 7-9 members to the Sound Ordinance Advisory Committee.

Background / Analysis:

Over the past year the City Council has discussed possible changes to the City Sound Ordinance. A number of citizens have also offered their input on revisions to this ordinance. In order to develop an ordinance that meets long-term community needs, the Council has decided to appoint an advisory committee to conduct a comprehensive review of the City sound regulations.

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The City of Fredericksburg

Attached is a copy of the applications that were submitted for this Committee by the November 15 deadline set by Council. Over the next several days we will verify that these applicants meet the requirements set by Council in terms of City residency or owner of a City business.

At Monday's Council meeting it is suggested that you, first of all, decide on the size of the committee. It is also recommended that you discuss the chairman position. Do you want to appoint the Chairman or should the committee appoint the chairman? Should the Chairman be a voting member of the Committee? You might also want to discuss the overall composition of the committee. For example, what backgrounds or experiences do you want to consider for committee members in order to provide a balance to the Committee? Finally, it is recommended that you discuss each name on the list to determine if any Council member knows the applicant and wants to offer their comments about each individual.

In the actual selection of the committee, the Council may want to have an open vote on the applicants. Of you may want to have a closed ballot and then vote on the names that receive the highest number of votes.

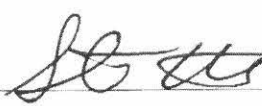

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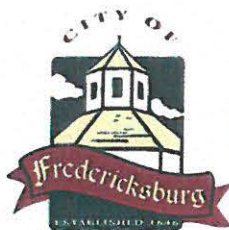
