**SUBJECT:** Waiver of Fees-Pacific Combat Zone Project

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### **Summary:**

The National Museum of the Pacific War has requested waiver of fees for both Phase 1 and Phase 2 of their Pacific Combat Zone improvement project. The total of City fees that they are requesting to be waived is \$14,757.82.

### **Recommendation:**

It is recommended that the Council consider the attached request for fee waiver along with a presentation at Monday's meeting on fees that have been waived for other government projects.

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### **Background / Analysis:**

The Pacific Combat Zone is currently undergoing major capital improvements as described in the attached letter from Joe Cavanaugh, Museum Director. Due to the significant economic benefit that the City will realize from these improvements, they are requesting waiver of City fees. As indicated in the attached letter, these fees include water and sewer impact fees as well as direct services and materials provided by the City Electric Department. The total fees requested for waiver is \$14,757.82. This includes material costs for the Electric Division totaling \$5,353.63.

Dear Council Members,

As the Pacific Combat Zone final plans are completed for all phases and the project is scheduled for phased opening over the next twelve months I am writing to ask for City support for major improvements to this important tourism venue.

The City has been a close partner as the museum has grown and matured since its birth almost fifty years ago, and the continued support the City provides has been a key to our success. The long-standing cooperation between the National Museum of the Pacific War and the City of Fredericksburg is a point of pride for the museum and mutually beneficial.

I request that the City Council waive all fees associated with the Pacific Combat Zone property development for the following reasons:

1. This development is designed to increase visitation, and therefore increase Fredericksburg tourism. In anticipation of this increase, two new facilities are being constructed during the first phase to accommodate visitors: a new Ticketing Center and new restroom facility near the entrance. For the first time the public will have the option to purchase their 48 hour ticket and start their visit at the Pacific Combat Zone and, with the new self-guided tour, will be able to go at any time and spend whatever time they choose. With an investment of \$8 million, the upgraded facilities and self-guided exhibits are designed to match the quality of the George H.W. Bush Gallery. All these elements were planned to enhance the visitor experience. Phase 1 will open in March, 2016.
2. In addition to the facilities already described, Phase 2 will include a new 9,100 square foot building for the maintenance and storage of all the historic vehicles, and new facilities to house participants in the Living History Program. While we

are designing facilities to be energy-efficient, we anticipate the combined facilities will increase usage of City services, both electrical and water/sewer, and we have already paid a Sewer Tap fee. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2016, with the first Living History Program using the new Amphitheater and battlefield scheduled for March, 2017.

**SUBJECT:** Consider Request by the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church for use of Historic Restoration Funding.

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**Summary:**

The Historic Review Board has been working with the owners of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church to preserve and maintain the building located at 520 E. Main Street. The City Council granted the church \$25,000 in funding for Fiscal Year 2014-15 from the Historic Preservation Fund. The funds have been utilized and the exterior of the church has been restored and is protected from the elements and demolition. The church made a presentation to the Historic Review Board in November and showed them all the work that has been accomplished, along with a list of items they intend to accomplish in future phases. A copy of the itemized list is attached.

**Recommendation:**

The Historic Review Board considered the list of items and felt that only the items necessary to restore the exterior of the church and preserve it from further deterioration should be considered for funding. The Historic Review Board voted unanimously to recommend that the City Council grant the church funding from the Historic Preservation Fund in the amount of \$3,375 to cover the items highlighted on the list. Staff concurs with the Review Board's Recommendation.

**SUBJECT:** Approval of Software Contract with Tyler Public Safety

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**Summary:**

The Fredericksburg Police Department has for many years, used Odyssey, a subsidiary of Tyler Technologies, for our Records Management System. Gillespie County recently made a software change in their Dispatch Services Software to a sister company of Tyler Technologies called Tyler Public Safety. Odyssey has been the records management software for both the Gillespie County Sheriff's Office and the Fredericksburg Police Department for many years. Odyssey was originally designed to service law enforcement, the County Courts System, and the Gillespie County Probation Department. Odyssey operated with an emphasis on the County Courts Systems. Tyler Public Safety has since been developed with an emphasis on Law Enforcement and the Dispatch Services. Tyler Public Safety offers several options for Law Enforcement that we do not currently have with Odyssey. The first is an RMS (records management software) program for Law Enforcement which would allow the Fredericksburg Police Department to interface with several other agencies currently using the same software, thus allowing officers to share information in real time. Second is the ability to interface with dispatch through mobile data terminals in our patrol cars. In changing over to Tyler Public Safety the Fredericksburg Police Department will be able to access all old data while still using the new software. Tyler Technologies is a proprietary software, not allowing the use of a different supplier for the RMS, making them a single source provider.

**Recommendation:**

Recommendation is that the City of Fredericksburg City Council accept the contract presented by Tyler Public Safety for \$34,119 a year for six years.

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**Background / Analysis:**

The Fredericksburg Police Department currently pays Tyler Technologies \$66,600 a year for software and server storage to use Odyssey, the current RMS provider. Changing over to their sister company, Tyler Public Safety, will cost the city \$37,254 for a six year contract and will then reduce to approximately \$23,000, at today's pricing. Switching from Odyssey to Tyler Public Safety will allow the Fredericksburg Police Department to see an immediate cost reduction of \$31,000 a year.

**SUBJECT:** Approval of Software Contract with Brazos E-Ticketing

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**Summary:**

In 2012 the Fredericksburg Police Department entered into a four year contract with Copsync to provide software for Mobile Data Terminal capabilities. The MDT's provided the Fredericksburg Police Department with direct access to the State's Criminal Justice Information Sharing Network. It also allowed officers to submit reports from their vehicles and provided an access pathway to the municipal courts via E-Ticketing, with an extra cost of \$1600 per year to interface with Incode, the Municipal Courts Software.

Tyler Technologies has an E-Ticketing Software through a subsidiary company called Brazos Technologies. The Software is a proprietary software with Tyler companies which is necessary for the interface with Tyler Public Safety and In-Code. This Software would allow the Fredericksburg Police Department to interface with our Tyler Public Safety RMS as well as the Municipal Court at no additional cost.

**Recommendation:**

Recommendation is That the City of Fredericksburg City Council accept the Brazos Technologies Contract for \$58,506 for E-ticketing software and hardware to operate.

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**Background / Analysis:**

Currently to use Copsynic as a pathway to the City of Fredericksburg Municipal Court we must pay for the interface with Incode which amounts to \$1600 a year. The total cost for Copsynic over the past four year contract was \$262,958 which included initial hardware setup. The cost to continue on Copsynic would be approximately \$36,000 a year for the software alone.

The cost for acquiring the Brazos Software would amount to a first year startup cost of \$32,100 for software. Each additional year after the first year would be \$6,000. The remainder of this one year contract, (\$26,406) is hardware cost for ticket writers and printers.
