Kent Myers, City Manager, reviewed the State Law for institution of annexation proceedings. He also reviewed the Legislation/House Bill regarding annexations.

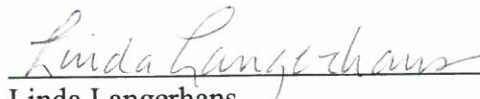

The City Council discussed the process used in the proceedings on the annexation and the properties who are ag exempted.

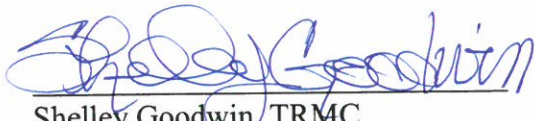
